- JCHAS is the premier, peer reviewed journal for the active safety professional. JCHAS features work practices, case studies and original research pertaining to all aspects of chemical safety.
- Any manuscript that helps a safety professional to get the job done will be considered.



# Comments on Style

■ What *JCHAS* is not:







- Relaxed formal style
- For all levels (B.S. Ph.D.)



# Before you start writing:

- English only (UK or US acceptable)
  - The #1 cause for rejection is poor English grammar
  - Non-native writers should get their MS reviewed by a native English speaker before submitting the article
  - Elston's English Rule: If I can't get though the abstract and the first 2 pages and understand the author's message, it will be rejected before it is sent for review.

- JCHAS Author's Guide
- The ACS Style Guide (current edition available from the American Chemical Society)
- For items not covered by the ACS Style Guide, see the Chicago Manual of Style (current edition is available online: chicagomanualofstyle.org, subscription required for full access)



# Style - References

- References are superscript/endnote style. (Papers will be sent back for revision to meet this)
- Online references must be fully documented
  - Should be peer reviewed sources
  - DOI (Digital Object Identifier) is satisfactory



# Style - References

- Papers that are "in press" must be actually "in press" (that is – accepted for publication). DOI use is best here.
- Published papers should be fully documented; DOI acceptable but prefer full citation.



# Author's Guide Highlights

- Available at ees.elsevier.com/jchas
- No word count limit: Say what you need to say to get the message across
- Double space the manuscript please



# **Figures**

- Figures are important and encouraged
- Figures must be:
  - High quality
  - High resolution (1200 dpi or better)
  - High contrast
  - Digital only (JPEG or GIF)
- Figures MAY be embedded in Word or WordPerfect Document



# **Figures**

- Color figures are OK, but...
  - Color figures will appear in B&W in the print, bound copy of JCHAS
  - Color figures will be in color in author's PDF proofs and digital versions



## Figures – IMPORTANT NOTE

If you <u>absolutely require</u> a figure to be in color in the bound journal, you will be charged \$300 per occurrence by Elsevier.



# Required Files

- Cover letter (indicate potential COI and funding sources if any)
  - Indicated potential COI is not cause for rejection. Real COI should be acknowledged in MS, but is not cause for rejection)
- Abstract (in a separate file)
- Manuscript



# Required files

- Figures if not embedded in MS
- Tables if not embedded in MS



- The system can be a bit confusing and, at times, user hostile
  - Don't get frustrated get help contact the editor first.
