
- Drivers of Corporate Behavior
 - Profit Business Growth
 - Public Image
 - Risk Tolerance
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- Impact of the litigation on Pacific Gas and Electric
 - Huge Settlement and Litigation
 Costs
 - Removal of Chromium-based rust inhibitors from cooling towers
 - Improved O&M procedures



- Litigation Tolerance
 - Pool Chemical Manufacturers
 - Reliance on the Federal Hazardous Substances
 Act (FHSA)
 - FHSA & CPSC safe harbor label language

Indiana couple injured while mixing "2 identical pool chemicals" in their kitchen



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 - Pool Chemical Manufacturers
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 - Paints & DIY Products
 - Concrete

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- Litigation Tolerance
 - Cosmetic Manufacturers
 - Lipsticks & perfumes contained phthalates
 - Publicity of emerging knowledge regarding toxicity led to reformulations
 - Avoid litigation
 - Avoid regulatory action





- Impediments to Litigation Influence
 - Sealed verdicts
 - Cheaper to defend than change


- Litigation in Organizations: Antisocial Behavior or Quest for Justice?
 - E. Allan Lind Sage Publications
 - General Motors settled a discrimination lawsuit
 - > \$3 million in direct payments,
 - >\$13 million in raises for employees who said they had been discriminated against,
 - Changes in pay raise practices that were estimated to cost between \$20 million and \$40 million over several years

- Political Values, Culture, and Corporate Litigation
- Corporations with "Democratic" Political leaning
 - Less likely to be sued for environmental, labor, or civil rights-related litigation
- Corporations with "Republican" Political leaning
 - Less likely to be sued for securities fraud and intellectual property rights violations
