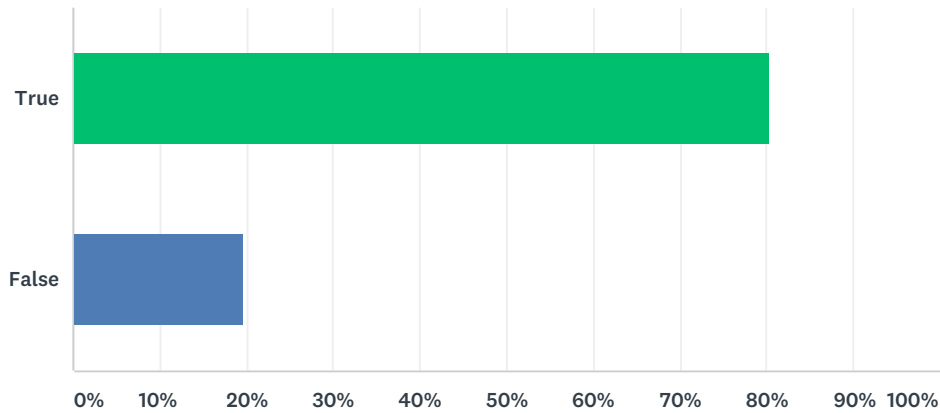


Q10 I think that the SDS program at my company is meeting OSHA's intended purpose of providing employees with information needed to work with chemicals safely.
